# THE POST 1947 RHYTHM-STYLE SERIES

Most of the data presented here comes from the research of the late Frank Phillips of Retford, Nottingham, England. Frank's children, John and Claire, kindly gave me Frank's archives shortly after Frank's death.

Frank had collected records in the Parlophone 'Rhythm Style' and related series for many years, and assembled a large archive of data relating to these records and the Parlophone Company. Although initially assembling this archive as a unified work, he quickly realised that its size was beyond that of a single volume, and privately circulated parts of it as documents covering specific aspects to fellow researchers. He produced documents covering the Parlophone 'Race' Series, the Parlophone Company in Britain, the Columbia-Lindström-Okeh-Parlophone company relationships, and the Parlophone Rhythm Style Booklets. His ultimate aim was to produce a volume for each Parlophone series, and in January 2012 produced a large, profusely illustrated 98 page volume covering the first 'New Rhythm Style' series.

Frank had intended to produce a work on the post 1947 Rhythm Style series, and his archive contains a title page, proposed lists of all the records issued in the series detailing which he owned, which he had inspected, and which he needed to inspect, plus listings of record numbers, performers and titles for each of the yearly series. His reason for this may have been that the last Parlophone Rhythm style booklet had been published in 1948, covering all the earlier series to the end of 1947, and no document had been issued covering any of the later series. In his own words, from his 1999 lists :

*The series of 1948 & 1949 saw the virtual conclusion, for whatever reason, of the issue of American sourced recordings in the 'Rhythm-Style' series, so that from the 1950 series onward, very few non-British artistes appeared. Also through the 1950's, the list of artistes remained relatively unchanged: Ray Ellington's last issue was R3262 (1950), and Graeme Bell's Australians left for home at the end of 1951; then Kenny Baker left Parlophone in late 1954, and Cleo Laine shortly afterwards; the Skiffle craze was covered by the introduction of the Vipers Skiffle Group, making their first appearance in the 1956 series. Other than these exceptions the list remained, to the end with: Crane River Band, Joe Daniels Jazz Group, Johnny Dankworth, The Kirchin Band, Humphrey Lyttelton, Jack Parnell, Freddy Randall, and the Saints Jazz Band providing the bulk of issues year on year.*

Frank did not have access to many of the sources now available via the internet, so his work has been updated and edited to produce this brief booklet along the lines of his earlier works.

I was lucky enough to obtain photographs of the late Frank Andrews' notebooks on the R100 series in early 2020 thanks to Bill Dean Myatt and Mike Thomas, so much of the additional information came from that. It is worth noting that even an eminent discographer like Frank Andrews working in the EMI Archives was unsuccessful in sorting out these later Rhythm Style Series completely.

Frank Phillips had also added a list of records which could be considered as Rhythm Style material in the final years, but had been issued on the normal R100 Series 'Red label'. My personal feeling is that much Jazz music had become part of the popular music genre by the latter part of the 1950's decade, with people like Humphrey Lyttelton and Acker Bilk featuring on radio and television, so there was no longer a need to single out these recordings as of special interest, and the Rhythm Style brand faded out.

There is much that can be confirmed and added including biographies, discographies, Parlophone catalogues excerpts, supplements and advertising, but this first edition will cover the bare details. And who knows what may be discovered by chance slipped in or misfiled in Frank's archive organisation in the future?

## The 1948 Super Rhythm-Style Series

Frank Phillips' listing for the 1948 series threw up some difficult problems. He had noted in 1999 that some of the 'side' numbers had been duplicated ...

*The unused 'side' numbers (17 & 18) in the 1939 'R- S' series has been the subject of some discussion (and speculation) but there may well be another instance of a similar anomaly in the 1948 series. There is also evidence of two occurrences within the 1948 series of 'side' numbers being duplicated (R3119 & R3132 both appear to have 'sides' numbered 35 & 36, while R3124 & R3141 both have 'sides' 41 & 42). Unfortunately, this has left me with one fewer catalogue numbers than places to be filled - unless this is another case of unused 'side' numbers.*

... but had not managed to view details of enough record labels to fully appreciate the extent of this duplication. Internet searches revealed that sides 35 to 46 had been duplicated, and that R3133 (sides 37 and 38) had been later released with labels declaring that they were sides 59 and 60, and R3142 (sides 41 and 42) had been released with labels as sides 65 and 66. If the known duplicated sides were later intended to be issued labelled with side numbers to follow the last issued record (R3160 with sides 55 and 56), R3133 and R3142 would have these numbers.
